General Guidelines for Diocesan Youth Events:

- ◆ To ensure safety of all attendees, any youth driving to an event will hand in the vehicle keys at the event check-in.
- ◆ To ensure a safe environment for each individual, drugs, alcohol, and tobacco products are not allowed.
- ◆ Accommodations will be made for dietary and/or physical needs. (Please list any restrictions with your medical information.)
- ◆ Youth events are a gathering of friends. Please refrain from exclusive or cliquish groupings.
- ◆ We want your parents to allow you to come to other events, so no changing your appearance in any lasting way while at an event.
- ◆ This is a church gathering, come as one who is, or wishes to be, a friend of Jesus and His friends.

Additional Camp Expectations:

- ◆ Nothing that could be considered a weapon is allowed.
- ◆ Bring clothing for a variety of activities such as hiking, cold evenings, hot days, swimming, sports, etc.
- ◆ Leave pets and fireworks at home; avoid wild animals.
- ◆ Respect camp property and the property of others.
- ◆ Some areas of camp are off-limits—follow staff guidelines.
- ◆ Everyone helps with the work at camp.
- ◆ Gameboys, Walkmans, and other valuables will be collected upon arrival at camp for safekeeping, and returned upon departure.
- ◆ Daily worship is part of the camp program. Be respectful.
- ◆ Completion of registration grants permission to use photos of the camper (taken at camp) for publicity purposes.
